Webster, New York –Blue Springs Energy helped its clients, primarily New York municipal governments, secure \$6,847,385 million of Federal and State clean energy grants and incentives over the past 9 months. This energy efficiency and renewable energy funding will provide approximately \$1.3 million in energy cost savings each and every year and reduce carbon emissions by over 8.7 million pounds, the equivalent of taking 754 cars off the road.
